 if in any ^{part} expended on his behalf by the Court here adjudged and the said Thomas in obeying &c.

 vs William Wboardaniel } Judgment of Cognovit Actionem,

Charles County vs. William Wboardaniel late of Charles County Well Right was
 Attached to Cognovit unto Joseph Aderton of afo. of Inspecto upon the Case and so forth
 And whereupon to the same Joseph Aderton in his proper Person Complain
 that whereas the said William the first day of December in the year of our Lord one Thousand
 seven Hundred and forty six at Charles County afo. afo. was indebted to the said
 Joseph Aderton in the sum of Two Thousand four Hundred and a half Pound of Tobacco
 for divers Articles lying Property in an Auction as by the Particular account there of here
 into Court brought may appear and being so there of indebted the afo. Daniel
 in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year afo. at the County afo.
 Upon himself assumed and to the said Joseph then and there faithfully promised that
 he the afo. William the said sum of Two Thousand four hundred and a half Pound of Tobacco to
 the said Joseph when there unto afterwards he should be requested will and truly would
 Content and Pay Nevertheless the afo. said William Wboardaniel his Promise
 assumption afo. not regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the
 same Joseph in this part craftily and subtly to deceive and defraud the afo. William
 the afo. said sum of Two Thousand four hundred and a half Pound of Tobacco or any part thereof to the
 same Joseph hath not paid nothing for the same in any sort Contented altho the afo. were
 afterwards to wit the first day of December in the year afo. one Thousand seven
 Hundred and forty seven and often afterwards at Charles County afo. said by the same
 Joseph hath been requested but the same to him hitherto, to Pay other for the same in any
 sort to Content with hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the
 Damage of the same Joseph Aderton four Thousand and Nine Pounds of Tobacco &
 therefore suit is brought and so forth
