pp^o Chris^o Wilkinson Judgment of Cognovit

It was Commanded the Sheriff that he should take Christopher Wilkinson late of Charles County Planter of 86^o and him self safe keep so that he should have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Seat County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next to answer unto William Neale of plea of trespass upon the Case and of forth and that he should have them and there that Writ 86^o

At which day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo^o Comes the said William by Henry Darnall his attorney and offers himself against the said Christopher and the Sheriff afo^o Namely Thomas Hungerford Gentleman Returns to the Court here that he has taken the body of the said Christopher

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person Comes Aaron Hally of Charles County and becomes pledge and surety for the said Christopher that if he should happen that the said Christopher in the plea afo^o should be convicted that then the said Aaron would and granted that so well the Damages afo^o as all Costs which to the said William in this part should be adjudged of his Lands and Chattels should be made and levied to and for the use of William if it should happen the said Christopher the Damages and Costs afo^o to the said William should not pay or his body in to the Custody of the Sheriff by Breach thereof Ponder

And the said Christopher in his proper Person Comes and defends the force and injury therein 86^o and vouches that he cannot deny the action afo^o of him the said William nor best that he owes to the said William the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy Eight Pounds of Tobacco as the said William Above opposes

Whereupon the said William by his attorney afo^o prays Judgment and those Damages so Acknowledged to gether with his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said William do Recover against Christopher his Damages afo^o to One Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy Eight Pounds of Tobacco as above Acknowledged also One Hundred and fifty Five ^{Three quarters of a pound} for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out and Expended on his afo^o part by
