

# March Court Anno Domini; 1747

Shew Samuel Hanson Junr Debtor Judgment Bond

1746 Thomas Thompson Junr Judgment of Nonsum Informatus

Charles County for Thomas Thompson Junior late of Charles County by his Attorney called Thomas Thompson Junr. Supra was summoned to answer unto Samuel Hanson Junior of a plea that he had craved him the sum of seven hundred and seven pounds of Tobacco which to him he owes and unjustly detaineth and so forth

And whereupon the same Samuel by his Attorney saith that he owes the said Thomas Thompson Junr the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven at Charles County a certain Writing obligatory bound himself to the said Samuel in the said sum of seven hundred and seven pounds of Tobacco to be paid to the said Samuel within after the said Thomas Thompson Junior should be lawfully requested. Nevertheless the said Thomas altho' often requested hath not paid to the said Samuel the said sum of seven hundred and seven pounds of Tobacco nor any part thereof but hath to wit together with and still doth refuse to pay the same to the damage of the said Samuel Hanson Junior seven hundred and seven hundred and forty eight pounds of Tobacco and therefore suit is brought and so forth and he bringeth here into Court the said Writing obligatory which gives sufficient testimony of the Debt aforesaid the date whereof is the day aforesaid

And the said Thomas Thompson Junior by Henry Darnall his Attorney saith that he doth deny the force and injury when the said Writing obligatory aforesaid was read unto him and he prayeth appearing of the condition of the said Writing obligatory and it is read unto him in these words following to wit

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Thompson Junior shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Samuel Hanson Junior his certain Attorney Executors Administrators or assigns the just and full sum of seven hundred and seventy seven pounds of Tobacco of present currency at or upon the first day of day of June next ensuing the date hereof with legal interest for the same then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force and virtue in law but if default be made in the payment of the said sum of seven hundred and seventy seven pounds of Tobacco of present currency then I empower any Attorney in any Court of Record in the Kingdom of Great Britain France or Ireland or within the province of Maryland or other his Majesty's Dominions to appear for me at the suit of the above mentioned Samuel Hanson Junr and to receive a Declaration on the above obligation, and thereupon to bring Judgment by Writ of Cognovit Actionem Nonsum Informatus or otherwise whereby releasing all the errors that may happen upon the said Judgment saving out Exceptions thereupon or in any of the proceedings hereunto relating
