in his own person Comes and defends to the force and injury when the said Clement nor but that he owes to the said Clement the sum of Eight Hundred and sixty one pounds of Tobacco as the said Clement above supposes.

Whereupon the said William by his Attorney proposed the said Judgment and that Damages so taken should be taken with his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this part had and should be paid by the said William to be adjudged.

Therefore is concluded by the Court here that the said William his Damages aforesaid to Eight Hundred and sixty one pounds of Tobacco and Charges by him about his suit in this part had and should be paid by the said William in Money to be adjudged.

Whereupon it was Com. manded the Sheriff of the County Charles and credits of the afore said Lawrence Macnamara in his Bailynick being in the County Charles well the sum of Ten shillings and Twenty six pounds of Tobacco Damages by the said Robert Haislip and Twenty six pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further the Sheriff pursue in prosecution of the same and when the same he had taken any part thereof that he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of this Neck County Court to be held at Charles Town on Wednesday in March Next then and there to be sold and according to Law to and for the Use of the said Robert Haislip the said Lawrence should come there by these by himself or lawful Attorney and Answer unto Robert's plea of Trespass upon the Case.
