It was commanded the Sheriff that he should take George Sawin late of Ch. Co. his County Sheriff of the County of Middlesex and him wife keep so that he should have his body before the Justices of his Lord Proprietary of his said County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March next to be measured James Cummings of a Debt of Treasures upon the said and that he should have them and there this 17th of 1716

And that day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo. Comes the said James Cummings by sworn ish. Chas. his attorney and offers himself against the said George and his wife afo. returns to the Court here that he has taken the body of the said George Sawin

And the aforesaid George in his proper Person comes on a defense by his attorney and swears that he is not the author of the said Debt of Treasures but that he owes to the said James the sum of four pounds currency and no more

Whereupon them the said James by his attorney afo. pray Judgment and those Damages so acknowledged together with his costs and charges by him about his suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged

Therefore it is considered by the Court that they the said James do recover against the said George his Damages afo. to four pounds of shillings above Acknowledged and also the sum of one hundred and twenty two pounds of shillings for his costs and charges by him about his suit in this part laid out and Expended on his behalf by the Court here adjudged and the said George Sawin in money 1716
