

Whereupon it was Commanded the Sheriff that of the Goods Chattles and Credits of the said Thomas in his Bailiwick being he should attach a writ of two pounds three shillings and six pence currency Damages as also two hundred pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had run and that further may run in Prosecution of the Premises and when the same he had attached or any part thereof that he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his best County Court to be held as soon as the Lord Tuesday in March Next then and there to be condemned according to Law to and for the use of the said Daniel Stephenson, unless the said Thomas Davis Junior should come then and there or his Lawfull Attorney and Answer unto the said Daniel Stephenson giving Satisfaction upon the Law, and that by good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make known to the said Persons in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he shoud be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and time aforesaid to shew Cause if any he shoud or they have why the sum in their or any of their hands attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Daniel Stephenson have the Execution of the same and how he should make that he should make known to the Justices aforesaid at the Time and Place aforesaid, and that he should have there and there that Wit and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid Comes the said Daniel by Jeremiah Chase Attorney and offers himself against the said Thomas in the plea aforesaid and the Sheriff aforesaid returns to the Court here the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz.

Charles Countys, I Hereby Certifie that by Virtue of the Writ then writ to me Directed on the 10. day of March 1746 I attached in the hands of Henry Moore the whole Damages & Costs, and I have made known to the Garnishee aforesaid that he be & appear before the Justices of the said County Court at the time and place within heretofore so shew Cause why the same Effects so attached in his hands should not be condemned to and for the use within mentioned Daniel Stephenson before John Evans and John Hanson Esqrs Two good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick as am hereby Comanded

Therefore it is Considered that the said Daniel have Condemnation of his Damages aforesaid to two pounds three shillings and six pence currency as also the sum of two hundred and fifty nine pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by in and about the Damages laid out and Repaid by the Court here aforesaid according to the force form and Effect of the Act of Assembly in those Cases here made and Provided and that the said Daniel have the Execution
