Luke Morris after the Twenty first day of September in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty two to wit the fifteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty six at Charles County afo. by his certain Writing under the hand and Seal of him the said Luke Morris bearing date the day and year last mentioned according to the form and Effect of the Act of Assembly in such behalf made and Provided, assigned the said Writing obligatory to the said Thomas and John for Value Received as therein mentioned afo. and assigned the said Thomas and John afterwards to wit on the said fifteenth day of August in the year last mentioned at Charles County afo. to the said Corn. Chase Holder and the said Thomas and John in full say that the said Cornelius altho often Requested the aforesaid sum of seventy six pounds four shillings of Paper Currency to the said Thomas and John or to either of them hath not paid nor any
