And the said Cornelius Sanford in his proper person Came & appeared before and Injury taken &c. and prays leave thereof to depart until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March, Next and he has and same day is given, the said Thomas Morris and John Delowier here &c.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid comes with the said Corn: in his proper person as the said Thomas & John by their attornys afo. and the said Thomas & John by their aforesaid pray that the said Cornelius to their Declaration afo. of them the said Thomas and John does not answer nor the Delin. afo. in any wise gain say nor by the said Thomas & John remain against the said Cornelius Sanford thereupon without defence

It is therefore considered by the Court here that the said Thomas & John do answer against the said Corn: their Debt by occasion of the Summons and which by the Justice of the Court here as aforesaid is twenty Sea pounds four shillings & pence as also three Hundred & fifty pounds of Tobacco for their costs & Charges by him about their suit in this part laid out and Expended to the said Thomas and John of their aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and the same Cornelius in
