Betw. I rememb'red that heretofore to wth the second Tuesday in March last by the oath of Fifteen Jurors namely Thomas Matthews &c was presented Jane Talford for bearing a bastard Child — ¶ Wt. & now here at this day to wth the second Tuesday in June aforesaid Tho's Jane on behalf of the Sheriff of Hertfordshire & small sum of Geal to the Court he brought in her Proper Person before being demanded of her by the Court here whether she be guilty of the fact aforesaid above upon her Imposition, she the said Jane say she is thereof guilty in manner & form as by the presentment aforesaid against her is alledged —

by the Court here that the said Jane before her hundred Pounds to be paid by her selfe & current money for her offence aforesaid according to the force of a mandat issued by the Act of Assembly in those cases so late made and provided and the same delivered by the Sheriff of Hertfordshire into Court here in his Proper Person comes to the Court of the County Blacksmith and becomes Pledge and Security for the aforesaid Jane to pay the fine aforesaid also the several sumes suspended to the officer and mines afoot the Court here by Quasion of the Petition — ¶ Ruled that the said Jane Talford recognizeth in the sum of Ten pounds Current money with sufficient security in the sum of five pounds like money for her appearance here on the second Tuesday in August next to testify for the Lord Proprietary against certain Richard Gray Esq: and concerning his Begetting a bastard Child on the body of the said Jane — ¶ Whereupon went into Court here in her Proper Person comes the said Jane Talford of Hertford County Spinster and her husband Richard Gray Esq: and standeth bound to his said Lord Ship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Current money of Maryland and also in like manner Jane Proctor Minion of Chafford County Blacksmith and acknowledged himselfe to sue and stand Securly Indebted to his said Lord Ship in the sum of five pounds like money which sum they and othermoreserally yielded and granted should be made and paid on their and each other's Goods & Chattels Lands and Tenements for the said his said Lord Ship his Heirs & Successors, On condition that the said Jane Talford do make her personal appearance here on the second Tuesday in August next then and there to give evidence behalfe of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary against certain Richard Gray Esq: and concerning his Begetting a bastard Child on the body of the said Jane where his Imposition & not appear the same Court without license —
