Jane Telford's Conviction & Submission

Be it Remembered that heretofore to wit the second Tuesday next last by the oath of fifteen Jurors namely Thomas Matthews &c was presented Jane Telford for bearing aboard Child — Mr. Rowher at this day to wit the second Tuesday in June aforesaid the said Jane in custody of the Sheriff namely Samuel Hanson Gent to the Court here brought in her Paper Pardon Com of her age & Demanded of her by the Court here whether she be guilty of the aforesaid offence above upon her Imposed, she thereupon say she is thereof guilty in Manner & Form as by the Presentment afo. against her is alleged

Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Jane be fined Six Hundred Pounds or thereabouts current money for her offence afo. according to the force of a mand. issued by the act of assembly in those cases late made and Provided and the said Jane did then & thereupon into Court here in his proper Person come Robert Minion of Charles County to take with and become Pledge and security for the said Jane to pay the fine afo. as also the several fees & expenses to the officer and ministers of the Court here by occasion of the said offence — It is that the said Jane Telford do give

in the sum of Ten pounds current money with sufficient surety in the sum of five pounds current money for her appearance here on the second Tuesday in August next to testify for the Lord Proprietary against certain Richard Gray Gent and concerning his begetting aboard Child on the body of the said Jane — Whereupon into

Court here in her proper Person come the said Jane Telford of Charles County Spenser and she thereupon engaged herself to come and stand surety to the said Lord Ship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds current money of Maryland and also in like manner to come and stand surety to his said Lord Ship in the sum of five pounds current money which she and of them severally should and granted should be made and paid on their and each of their Goods & Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lord Ship his Heirs & Successors,

On condition that the said Jane Telford do make her personal appearance here on the second Tuesday in August next then and there to give evidence on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary against certain Richard Gray Gent and concerning his begetting aboard Child on the body of the said Jane as being his Privileges & not depart the same Court without License
