That she is thereof guilty in manner and form as by the presentment aforesaid
 above against her it is alleged. **Therefore** it is considered that
 the said Jane Minton be fined or suffer corporal punishment according to the directions
 of the act of Assembly in those cases late made and provided, and yet that the said
 Jane cannot pay or procure any person to be security for the payment of the said fine.
 It is ordered the Sheriff that he take the said Jane to the Whipping Post and having
 stripped her naked from the waist upwards there give her Twenty lashes on the
 bare back for her offence. **And afterwards** to wit the same Tuesday
 the said Jane returned to the Court here that she hath done part of
 the said judgment upon the said Jane. **Whereupon** into Court here in
 his proper Person came Thomas William Bryan of Charles County Inholder
 and became Pledge and security for the said Jane to pay the several fees due to the
 officers and ministers of the Court here by reason of the Premises in consideration
 whereof and the trouble of his Honour. **It is adjudged** by the Court here that
 that the said Jane do save here with the said William Bryan Guaranty of half after
 the expiration of her time of service now due.

 became Pledge and security for the said Alexander to pay the fine aforesaid and also the
 several fees due to the officers and ministers of the Court hereby reason
 of the Premises.
