You Charles Brayeroff Richard Liden Ignatius Doyme Edward Clement and Benjamin Brayeroff as before Judgment to Edmund Jennings Esq. as well for the sum of Eleven pounds fourteen Shillings and Three pence Sterling Damages as Three Hundred and fifty Nine pounds of Tobacco Costs, which sum were Debted by the said Edmund Jennings against Charles Brayeroff on the fifth day of March last past in Charles County Court, the said Eleven pounds fourteen Shillings and Three pence Sterling Damages, and Three Hundred and fifty Nine pounds of Tobacco to be levied of your body's Goods & Chattels and on your Tenements for the use of the said Edmund Jennings In Case the said Charles Brayeroff shall not pay and Satisfie to the said Edmund Jennings the said sum of Eleven pounds fourteen Shillings and Three pence Sterling, and Three Hundred and fifty Nine pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid
