It was Comanded the Sheriff that he should take Charles Craycroft late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Charles Craycroft of Charles County of 60 and him self Heepers that he should have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Seat Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday of June next to satisfy unto George Swain as well the sum of four Shillings and three pence six pence and a half of good sound Merchantable Tobacco as also the sum of four Shillings and a half of good sound Tobacco which to the same George Swain in the County of the Lord Proprietary before the Justices of Charles County afo. Recovered against the said Charles Craycroft as also four hundred and eighty one pounds of Tobacco which to the same George by Discretion of the Justice afo. of his afo. were adjudged for his Damages which he had by Detention of Detaining that Debt whereof the said Charles Craycroft and that he should have them the 11th of May 47. — All now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in June 1747 the Sheriff the said returns to the Court here the 11th of June thus answered viz.

Wardrop & Graham against Charles Craycroft on the twelfth day of March last in Charles County County Court the said six pounds six pence and a half of good sound Merchantable Tobacco to be lessed of your body's Good and Charles Craycroft's Sentences for the full of the said 11th of June Wardrop & Graham In case the said Charles Craycroft shall not pay and satisfy to the said Messrs. Wardrop & Graham the said six pounds six pence and a half of good sound Merchantable Tobacco and Eighty one pounds of good sound Tobacco with additional costs thereon on the fifth day of February next. — Confessed the 6 day of June 1747
