It was Commanded the Sheriff that he should take Thomas Hanphior late of Charles County Planter of 80⁰⁰ and him safe keep so that you have his body before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Real Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in June next to satisfy unto Mess^{rs} Stephenson & Co. as well the sum of 500⁰⁰ Shillings and four hundred and six pence of Tobacco in two 11⁰⁰ which he should satisfy to the said Mess^{rs} Stephenson & Co. before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary for their Damages which they had by reason of a certain Promise and assumption to the same Stephenson and a Clerk at Charles County of 50⁰⁰ made and unperformed as also two hundred and ninety seven pounds of Tobacco to the same Stephenson & Co. for their expenses and charges for their ^{Costs} Damages & Charges by him about their suit in this Part laid out and Expended whereof the said Thomas is bound and that he should have then and there that Will 80⁰⁰ And Now here at this day being the second Tuesday in June of the said Year the Sheriff of the said County returns to the Court here the Will of the said Indorsed Viz^t — Capi Corpus Sam^l Hanphior 80⁰⁰

It was Commanded the Sheriff that he should take William Nail late of Charles County Planter of 80⁰⁰ and him safe keep so that you have his body before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Real Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in June next to satisfy unto Richard Giddard Jones as well the sum of nine hundred and ninety nine and a half pounds of Tobacco which to the said Richard Jones in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary of the said Year were adjudged for their Damages which they had by reason of a certain Promise and assumption to the same Richard Jones at Charles County of 50⁰⁰ made and unperformed as also two hundred and forty one pounds of Tobacco to the same Richard Jones of their expense and charges for their ^{Costs} Damages & Charges by him about their suit in this Part laid out and Expended whereof the said William is bound and that he should have then and there that Will 80⁰⁰ And Now here at this day to the second Tuesday in June (of the said Year)
