It is now Commanded the Sheriff that he should take James Murchison of Charles County
Weaver of 40^d and him safe keep so that he should have his body before the Justices
of the Lord Proprietary of his said County Court to be held at Charles Town on the
Second Tuesday in March Next to pay unto Edward Kellet as well the sum of One
Thousand pounds of Tobacco which to the said Edward in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary
before the Justices aforesaid was adjudged for his Damages which he had by occasion of a certain
Promise to the said Edward at Charles County aforesaid made and Unperformed as also
One Hundred Twenty six and a Quarter of a pound of Tobacco which to the same Edward aforesaid
Agent were adjudged for his Costs and Charges by him about this suit in this Court laid out &
Expended whereof the said Edward is Conviit 40^d and that he should have then and there
that Next 40^d And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid the
Sheriff aforesaid Returns to the Court three the next aforesaid day Indorsed Viz^r

It was Commanded the Coroners of Charles County that they should Rebelle Mr Douglass
late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Wm Douglass of Charles County Clerks aforesaid
and him safe keep so that they should have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of
his said County Court to be held at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in March Next
to pay unto Samuel Hanson Junr as well the sum of four Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty
four Pounds of Tobacco a certain debt which the same Samuel lately in the Court of the said
Lord Proprietary before the Justices of Charles County aforesaid recovered against the said Wm
as also Two Hundred and Eighteen Pounds and an half Pounds of Tobacco which to the
same Samuel by Discretion of the Justices aforesaid of his Agent were adjudged for his
Damages which he had by occasion of retaining that debt whereof the said William is
Conviit 40^d and that they should have then and there that Next 40^d And now here at this
