It was Commanded the Sheriff that he should take James Neale late of Charles County Weaver of 40^s and him safe Keep so that he should have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next to Satisfy unto Edward Kellert as well the sum of One Thousand pounds of Tobacco which to the said Edward in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justices aforesaid was adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of a certain Promise to the said Edward at Charles County aforesaid made and Unperformed as also One Hundred twenty six and a Quarter of a pound of Tobacco which to the same Edward of his absence were adjudged for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out & Expended whereof the said Edward is Convent 40^s and that he should have then and there that Writ 40^s. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid the Sheriff aforesaid Returns to the Court here the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz

It was Commanded the Coroners of Charles County that they should take Wm Douglas late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Wm Douglas of Charles County Planter of 40^s and him safe keep so that they should have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next to Satisfy unto Samuel Hanson Jun^r as well the sum of four Thousand Eight Hundred & sixty four Pounds of Tobacco a certain debt which the same Samuel lately in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justices at Charles County aforesaid recovered against the said Wm as also Two Hundred and Eighteen Pounds and an half Pound of Tobacco which to the same Samuel by Discretion of the Justices aforesaid of his absence were adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of retaining that debt whereof the said William is Convent 40^s and that they should have then and there that Writ 40^s.
