High Sheriff of Charles County as well the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred and Thirteen Pounds of Tobacco which to the said Samuel in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justices aforesaid was adjudged for his Damages which he had by occasion of a certain Promise and Assumption aforesaid made and unperformed as also Two Hundred Twenty Six Pound & Three Quarters of Tobacco which to the same Samuel of his aforesaid were adjudged for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this part laid out and Expended whereof the said W. Bryan is bound to pay and that they should have there that Writ &c.
