Sheriff of Charles County Assignee of William Widdleton as well the Sum of Two Thousand and Eighteen pounds of Tobacco which to the said Sam<sup>r</sup> Hanson Assignee of William Widdleton on the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justices afo<sup>r</sup> was adjudged for his Damages which he had by occasion of a certain Promise and Assumption to the said Samuel Assignee afo<sup>r</sup> made and unperformed as also Three Hundred and Ten Pounds of Tobacco which to the same Samuel Assignee afo<sup>r</sup> of his afo<sup>r</sup> was adjudged for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out and Expended whereof the said Arthur is Convoit 46<sup>s</sup> and that they should have them & then that Writ 46<sup>s</sup> And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo<sup>r</sup> John Wilder one of the Coroners afo<sup>r</sup> Returns to the Court true the Writ 46<sup>s</sup> thus Indorsed Viz.
