

March Court Anno Domini 1710

Next to satisfy unto William Middleton Junior assignee of William Middleton Senior as well the sum of Eight Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty Eight Pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco a certain Debt which the same Wm Middleton Junior assignee as lately in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justice at Charles County was recovered against the said Daniel as also Two Hundred Eighty ten Pounds and an half pound of Tobacco which to the same Wm assignee as by Discretion of the Justice as of his assent were adjudged for his Damages which he had by reason of certain one that Debt, whereof the said Daniel is Comitt 46. and that he should have then & there that Writ 46. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March 1710 the Sheriff returns to the Court that the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz.

Mem^o the Writ be release the penalty on paym^t of 1500^l 6^s 8^d Costs & Capi Corpus Sub. Viz. Sam: Hanson Esq^r

It was Commanded the Coroners of Charles County that they should take Bennet Hill late of Charles County Dancing Master of 46. and him safe keep so that they should have his body before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March next to satisfy unto Samuel Hanson Esq^r High Sheriff of Charles County as well the sum of Eight Hundred and Sixty one pound of Tobacco which to the said Samuel in the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justice as of his assent were adjudged for his Damages which he had by reason of a certain promise and assumption to the said Samuel at Charles County as made and unperformed as also Two Hundred six Pounds and an half Pound of Tobacco which to the same Samuel of his assent were adjudged for his Costs and Charges by him about this suit in this Court and outward Expended Monies of the said Bennet's Comitt 46. and that they should have then & there that Writ 46. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March 1710 Matthew Barnes one of the Coroners returns to the Court that the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz.

You Bennet Hill John Jenkins and Richard Valley do Confess Judgment to Sam Hanson for the sum of one Thousand Sixty seven and an half Pounds of Tobacco which sum was recovered by the said Samuel Hanson against the said Bennet Hill on the second Tuesday in November last in Charles County Court the said one Thousand Sixty seven and an half Pounds of Tobacco to be Seized of your Goods or Chattles Land or Tenements for the use of the said Sam: Hanson in case the said Bennet Hill shall not Pay and satisfy to the said Samuel Hanson the said one Thousand Sixty seven and an half Pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid recovered against him with the additional Cost there on on the first day of May next
