

Tobacco for costs that had accrued and that further should accrue in prosecution of the Premises and when the same they have attached or any part thereof that they should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his West County Court to be holden at Char: Town on the second Tuesday in March next then and there to be heard and according to law to and for the use of the said Samuel unless the said Thomas should come himself and there by himself or by full attorney and answer unto the said Samuel a plea of Trespass upon the Case and that by good and Lawfull men of their County which they should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands they should make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and time aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same in their or any of their hands attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Statute have there of Execution if so. And he or they should Execute that Writ that they should make known to the Justices aforesaid at the time and Place aforesaid and that they should have them and these that Writ and the Names of those before whom they should make the same known &c. All of whom here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid comes the said Samuel by Samiah Chase his attorney and offers himself against the said Thomas which as do in the Plea aforesaid and Samuel Chummons of the Coroners aforesaid return to the Court there the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz
