March Court Anne Domini 1718.

To oblige for costs that had accrued and that further should answer on prosecution of the premises and when the same they have attached or any Part there of that they should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be holden at Charlestown the second Tuesday in March next then and there to be condemned according to Law and for the use of the said Samuel unless the said Thomas should come then and there by himself or Lawfull attorney and answer unto the said Samuel of a plea of trespass upon the case and that by good and lawfull men of their County which they should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands they should make the same return that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and time aforeso to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same in their or any of their hands attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Samuel have thereof execution ifc. And how they should execute that will that they should make known to the Justices aforeso at the time and place aforeso and that they should have then and there that will and the names of those before whom they will make the same known &c. And nowhere at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforeso comes the said Samuel by Jeremiah Chase his attorney and offers himself against the said Thomas Richards In the Plea aforeso and Samuel Chunn one of the Coroners aforeso return to the Court house the White aforeso this 1st instant Ciz —

I hereby certify to the Worshipfull the Justices within mentioned that by Virtue of the within Writ I directed the twelfth day of November 1718 that on the seventeenth day of November 1718 I attarred on the Plantation of the within mentioned Thomas Richards for the use of the within mentioned Samuel Hanson sundry Goods as the Effects of the said Richards as by a Schedule hereto annexed and I have made known to the above garnishee that he be and appear before the Justices within mentioned at the time and place within prescribed to shew cause, if any he has, why the same should not be condemned according to Law for the use of the within mentioned Saml Hanson before John Thomas and Nefel Leach, good and lawfull men of County which aforeso hereby Commanded —
