Thomas Johnson's Judgment

Charles County vs. Thomas Johnson late of Charles County Plaintiff was Attached to answer unto Samuel Hanson Esq; High Sheriff of Charles County a plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth. And thereupon the same Samuel by Samuel Chase his Attorney complains that whereas the said Thomas the fourteen th day of Sept^r In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven at Charles County aforesaid was indebted to the said Samuel in the sum of Twelve Hundred and seventy six p^{ts} of Tobacco for divers Articles lying Properly in an Account as by the Particular Account thereof herewith into Court brought may appear and being so thereupon indebted the said Thomas in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid of the County aforesaid upon him self assumed and to the said Samuel then and there faithfully promised that he the said Thomas the said sum of Twelve Hundred and seventy six p^{ts} of Tobacco to the said Samuel when thereunto afterwards he should be requested, well and truly would Content and Pay. Nevertheless the said Thomas his Promise and Assumption aforesaid not regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the same Samuel in his Part Craftily and Subtily to deceive and defraud the said Thomas the said sum of Twelve Hundred & seventy six p^{ts} of Tobacco to the same Samuel hath not Paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented with the said Thomas afterwards to wit the Tenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty eight and often afterwards at Charles County aforesaid by the same Samuel hath been requested but the same to him hitherto to Pay or to Content for the same in any sort to Content hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth refuse to the Damage of the same Samuel Hanson and thousand five hundred and fifty two p^{ts} of Tobacco and therefore suit is brought and so forth.
