Whereupon on to Court here in his Proper Reason comes William Elbert of Charles County Merchant and becomes Judge and Security for the said Moses that if it should happen the said Moses in the place of should be found that then the said William should and granted that as well the Damages as all Costs which to the said Jeremiah in this Part should be ad judges of his Land & Chattles should be made and Levied to and for the Use of the said Jeremiah that if it should happen that the said Moses the Damages and Costs sh. to the said Jeremiah should not pay or his body in to the Custody of the Sheriff by reason here of tender.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March a. d. 1740. came here as well the said Jeremiah Aderton by his Attorney sh. and the said Jeremiah by his said Attorney Prays that this Motion to his Delegation against him may answer and the sh. Moses by Thomas Clark his Attorney sh. comes and defends the force and Injury when & so forth. And afterwards to wit the same second Tuesday in March a. d. 1740. as well the said Jeremiah as the said Moses do agree to submit that the whole matter in variance between them be Determined by Richard Harrison and Walter Hanson Gentlemen Deputies by the Court here of the consent of the Parties sh. Especially appointed. Whereupon it is said to the said Richard and Walter by the Court that
