That they have the whole matter in variance between the Parties afo. before the Court here &c. And afterwards to wit the same second Tuesday in March afo. Comes as well the said Jeremiah as the said Moses by their attorneys afo. as the said Richard Harrison & Walter Hanson the Referrees afo. who return to the Court here the following order Viz. Charles County sh. With the subscribers being appointed by the afo. County Court with the consent of Parties) as Referrees in an action now depending in said Court Jeremiah Aderton and Moses Drape do Certifie that after hearing the allegations and answers on both sides we find for the Plaintiff and give Damages to the sum of Eight Pounds one Shilling and five Pence Virginia Currency and that the Defendant pay the Costs given under our hands this Sixteenth March 1768

Whereupon the said Jeremiah Aderton by his attorney afo. prays Judgment of said Court upon the return of the Referrees afo. in form afo. found for him to be given. It is therefore ordered by the Court here that the said Jeremiah do recover against the said Moses his Damages afo. to Eight Pounds one Shilling and five Pence Virginia Currency of the Value of Twelve Pounds Eighteen Shillings and four Pence Maryland Currency so afo. by the Referrees afo. awarded as the sum of one Hundred and Sixty five Pounds of Isaac his Executors Charges by him about his suit in this Court said out and Expended by the Court here to the same Defendant Jeremiah of his afo. by the Court here adjudged and the said Moses Drape in money &c.

It was Commanded the Coronors of Charles County that they should take Edward Selling late of Charles County Planter of &c. and him safe keep till they should have his body before the Justice of the said Proprietary of his Neat County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March next to answer unto Samuel Hanson Esq. High Sheriff of Charles County of a plea of Trespass upon the Case &c. and they should have them and there that Wait &c. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo. Comes as well the said Sam. Hanson by Jeremiah Chase his attorney afo. and offers himself against the said Edw. Selling in the Plea afo. and Samuel Chunn one of the Coronors afo. returns to the Court here the Wait afo. thus Indorsed Viz. Capi Corpus Sam. Chunn Coronor

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo. Comes as well the said Sam. Hanson by his attorney afo. as the afo. Samuel Chunn one of the Coronors of Charles County to which the afo. Wait was directed and the said Edward Selling altho solemnly called comes not but makes default. Thereupon it is adjudged by the Court here that the said Samuel Chunn one of the Coronors afo. be awarded the sum of ^{the Damages afo.} thirteen Hundred and Twenty one pounds of &c.
