Moses Drape afterwards to wit the first day of December In the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Eight and often afterwards at Charles County aff: by the same Jeremiah Aderton hath been requested, but the same to him hindered to, to pay or him for the same in any sort Contented hath altogether refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the same Jeremiah Aderton Thirty Six Pounds Virginia Currency of the Value of Fifty Seven Pounds Twelve Shillings Maryland Currency and therefore suit is brought & so forth
