

March Court Term Dominica 1740

Mr. Batters and v. the same Second Tuesday in March 1740 as well the said... as the said Moses do agree and submit that the whole matter in Controversy between them be Determined by Richard Harrison and Walter Hanson Gent. Referees by the Court here of the Consent of the parties &c. Especially appointed. Whereupon it is said to the said Batters and Walter by the Court here that they have the whole matter in Controversy between the Parties before the Court here &c. Mr. Batters afterwards to wit the same Second Tuesday in March 1740 comes as well the said Jeremiah Aderton as the said Moses Drape by their attorneys &c. as the said Richard and Walter the Referees &c. who return to the Court here the following Award Viz.

Charles County fo. We the subscribers being appointed by the said County Court with Consent of Parties as Referees in an action now depending in said Court Jeremiah Aderton vs. Moses Drape do certify that after hearing the allegations and Accounts on both sides we find for the Plaintiff & give Damages to the sum of Eight Pounds one Shilling and five pence Virginia Currency and that the Defendant pay the Costs given under writ and this sixteenth March 1740

Whereupon the said Jeremiah Aderton by his attorney &c. prays Judgment of and Upon the return of the Referees &c. inform &c. found for him to be given. It is therefore concluded by the Court here that the said Jeremiah do recover against the said Moses his Damages &c. to Eight Pounds one Shilling and five Pence Virginia Currency of the value of Twelve Pounds Eightteen Shillings and four Pence Maryland Currency so ascert by the Referees &c. awarded as also the sum of One Hundred and Sixty five Pounds of Tobacco for his Costs & Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out and Expended by the Court here to the same Defendant Jeremiah Aderton of his Agent by the Court here adjudged and the said Moses Drape in money &c.
