Charles County sh. Whereas Charles Craig Complains that a certain Thomas Anglesby  
Drick Taylor is justly indebted to him the sum of fourteen hundred pounds of Tobacco  
of Tobacco and that the said Thomas Anglesby is Runaway with a Design to defraud him and his  
other Creditors. These are to require you on Sight hereof to issue an attachment for non return  
to directions of the Act of Assembly of this Province and this shall be your Warrant given under  
my hand and Seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1740. Just. Brown

Whereupon It was Comanded the Sheriff that of the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said  
Thomas Anglesby in his Parish which being he should detain as well the sum of fourteen  
hundred pounds of Tobacco Damages as Seven hundred pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had  
accrued and that further should execute in Execution of the Premises and when the same be had  
Attached or any Part thereof that he should have set before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his  
Next County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next then  
there to be condemned according to Law to and for the Use of the said Charles unless the said  
Thomas should Come therein and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and Answer unto the said  
Charles of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and that by Good and Lawfull manner of his Oath which  
he should make known to the Person or Persons whose hands he should make the same att.  
that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the Place & time  
aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the sum in this or any of their hands Attached  
should not be condemned according to Law and the said Charles have the Execution of the  
And how he should Execute that that he should make known to the Justices aforesaid at the time  
and Place aforesaid and that he should have shown there that that and the Names of those before whom  
he should make the same known &c. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March  
aforesaid Comes the said Charles by Jeremiah Chase his attorney and offers himself against the said Tho:  
in the plea aforesaid and the Sheriff's Return to the Court here the Just aforesaid thus worded Viz

Charles County sh. I hereby Certify to the Worshipfull the Justices within mentioned that by  
Virtue of the within writ to me directed that on the twentieth day of February 1740 I returned  
in the hands of Paul Grant for the whole Damages and Costs within mentioned and also on the 18<sup>th</sup> day  
of the same Month I returned in the hands of Repton Hungerford Senior for the whole Damages  
and Costs within mentioned and also on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March I returned in the hands of Stephen  
Chandler
