Thousand Three Hundred and Twelve Pounds of Tobacco Debts as also the Cost which shall accrue thereon
for the use of Benjamin Kendall given and my hand and seal this 13th day of February 1751/2

Whereas upon It was Commanded the Sheriff that of the Goods Chattels & Credits of
the Cap^t Thomas Angleby in his Rability being he should attach as well the sum of Three
Thousand Three Hundred and Twelve Pounds of Tobacco Duties as One Thousand Pounds of
Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further should run in Prosecution of the Promises
and when the same he had attached or any Part thereof that he should have it before the Justice
of the Lord Proprietor of his Neigh County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday
in March next then and there to be condemned according to Law to be sold for the use of the said Benj^t
Kendall unless the said Thomas Angleby should come then and there by himself or Lawfull
Attorney and answer unto the said Benjamin of Frauds upon the face and that by
Good and Lawfull men of his Rability he should make known to the Person or Persons in
whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he will or may be bound appear before
the Justice of the said Lord Proprietor at the Place and Time aboves^d to shew cause if any he shew
they have why the sum in their or any of their hands attached should not be condemned
according to Law and the said Benjamin Kendall have three of Execution ready and when he
should execute that Writ that he should make known to the Justice a^d at the time & place^d and
that he should have then and there that Writ and the Names of those before whom he should make
the same known i^e And now to set this day to wit the second Tuesday in March comes
the said Benjamin by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney and offers himself against the said Writ in
the Pleas and the Sheriff^d returns to the Court her the Writ a^d has record^d
