Whereas by the above Account and Probate it sufficiently appears to me that Thomas Anglesby stands Justly Indebted unto Benjamin Fendall the Quantity of Three Thousand Three Hundred and Twelve Pounds of Tobacco, and that the said Thomas is Runaway. These are in his Lordships Name to authorize you on sight thereof to issue Attachment against the Effects of the said Thomas Anglesby as well for the Quantity of Three Thousand Three Hundred and Twelve Pounds of Tobacco Debt as also the Cost which shall accrue thereon for the Use of Benjamin Fendall Esq. in and among hand and Seal this 13th day of February 1740^{ly}

Whereupon It was Comanded the Sheriff that of the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Thomas Anglesby in his Bailiwick being he should attach as well the sum of three Thousand Three Hundred and Twelve Pounds of Tobacco Duties as one Thousand Pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further should accrue in Prosecution of the Promise and when the same he had attached or any Part thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Seat County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Sunday in March Next then and then to be condemned according to Law to and for the Use of the said Benj. Fendall unless the said Thomas Anglesby should come then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and answer unto the said Benjamin of a plea of Assumpsit upon the Oath that by God and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he or they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the Place and Time aforesaid to show Cause if any he or they have why the sum in their or any of their hands Attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Benjamin Fendall have the Use of Execution of the said Debt and how he should execute that Writ that he should make known to the Justice aforesaid at the time & Place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that Writ and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c. And now here at this day to wit the second Sunday in March aforesaid comes the said Benjamin by Jeremiah Space his attorney and offers himself against the said Thos. in the Pleas and the Sheriff aforesaid returns to the Court here the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz
