Charles County sh^r William Carter Junior late of Charles County sh^r was att^d to answer unto James Rufell of a plea of trespass upon the case and so forth
 And whereupon the same James by Jeremiah Chase her attorney complains that whereas the said William the twenty fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty five at Charles County sh^r was indebted to the said James Rufell in the sum of one thousand seven hundred and seventy five Pounds of Tobacco for divers articles lying properly in an account as by the Particular account thereof herewith into Court brought may appear and being so the said William in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year afo^r at the County sh^r upon himself assumed and to the said James then and there faithfully promised that he the said William Carter Jun^r the said sum of one thousand seven hundred and seventy five Pounds of Tobacco to the said James when the account afterwards he should be required well and truly would content and pay nevertheless the said W^m his promise and assumption afo^r not regarding but cunningly and fraudulently intending the same James in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said William the said sum of one thousand seven hundred and seventy five Pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the same James hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort consented altho the said W^m Carter J^r afterwards to wit the Thirdday of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty eight and often afterwards at Charles County sh^r by the same James hath been required, but the same to him neither to, to pay for him for the same in any sort to Content hath neither to altogether refused and still doth refuse to the Damage of the same James Rufell three thousand four hundred and fifty Pounds of Tobacco and therefore this is brought forth
