Charles County s<sup>r</sup>: These are in his Lordships Name to Require you to Issue out Attachment against the Effects of William Busan whom John Blackwood hath made it appear to me that he is absconded and run away and that he is indebted to him Nine Hundred and Ninety Six Pounds of Tobacco as will appear by the said Blackwood Account which I may hand this day March 1710 Tho<sup>s</sup> Stone

Whereupon It was Commanded the Sheriff that of the Lord Chatters Executors of the aforesaid William Busan in his Bailiwick being he should attach as well the sum of Nine Hundred and Ninety Six Pounds of Tobacco Damages as Six Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further should accrue in Prosecution of the Premises and when this sum he had attached or any Part thereof that he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next then and there to be condemned according to Law to and for the use of the said John Blackwood unless the said William Busan should come then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and Answer unto the said Blackwood of a plea of Trespass upon the fact and that by good and Lawfull man of his Bailiwick he should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands he should make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary at the Place and Time afo<sup>r</sup> to show cause if any he she or they have why the sum or any of their hands attached should not be sold and according to Law and the said John have thereof Execution if &c. and how he should execute that that he should make known to the Justices aforesaid at the time and Place afo<sup>r</sup> and that he should have then & there that Writ and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in March afo<sup>r</sup> Comes the said John by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney and offers himself against the said William in the plea afo<sup>r</sup> and the Sheriff afo<sup>r</sup> returns to the Court here the Writ aforesaid thus Indorsed Viz<sup>t</sup>
