Whereupon It was Commanded the Sheriff that of the good Charles & Sons
of the aforesaid Oswald Adams in his Bailiwick being he should attach some the
Sum of Eleven Hundred and Twenty Six Pounds of Tobacco Damages as Six Hundred
Pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further should accrue in
Prosecution of the Premises and when the same he had attached or any Part thereof that
he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be
held at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in March Next then and there to be condemned
according to Law to and for the use of the said Robert Scott unless the said Oswald should come
then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and Answer unto the said Robert Scott a Plea of
Insufficiency upon the case and that by Good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make known
to the Person or Persons in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he be or
they be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the Place and Time
aforesaid to show cause if any he shoud they have why the sum in their hands attached
should not be condemned according to Law and the said Robert Scott have there of Execution if he
and how he should Execute that Writ that he should make known to the Justices at the Time
and Place aforesaid and that he should have them and have that Writ and the Names of those
before whom he should make the same known &c. And whereat this day to wit the Second
Tuesday in March aforesaid Comes the said Robert Scott in his proper person and offers himself against
the said Oswald in the plea aforesaid and the Sheriff returns to the Court true the Writ aforesaid the said
Charles County sh. Shereby certifies to the Worshipfull the Justices within mentioned that by
Virtue of the within Writ to me Directed, I attached the Effects of the within mentioned Oswald
Adams for the use of the within mentioned Robert Scott, as by a schedule of Appraisement
here unto Annexed may appear before Notley Maddoche John Harrison Junr. Just. Cooksey and
Edward Smoot Good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick

him to be adjudged. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the said Robert
Scott have there of Condemnation of the said goods amounting to one Hundred and
