Whereupon It was Commanded the Sheriff that of the Good Charles & Credit
of the aforesaid Oswald Adams in his Baileynich being he should attach and sue the
Sum of Eleven Hundred and Twenty Six Pounds of Tobacco Damages as Six Hundred
Pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further should pursue in
Prosecution of the Premises and when the same he had attached or any Part thereof that
he should have it before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be
held at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in March Next then and there to be condemned
according to Law to and for the use of the said Robert Scott unless the said Oswald should come
then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and Answer unto the said Robert Scott & pleas of
Suspense upon the same and that by Good and Lawfull men of his Baileynich he should make known
to the Person or Persons in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he shall or
they be and appear before the Justices of the said Lord Proprietary at the Place and Time
aforesaid cause if any he shal or they have why the sum in their hands attached
should not be condemned according to Law and the said Robert Scott have thereof Execution etc:
and how he should execute that Effect that he should make known to the Justices at the Time
and Place aforesaid that he should trace then and there that he and the Names of those
before whom he should make the same known etc: And moreover at the day to meet the Second
Tuesday in March next Comes the said Robert Scott in his proper person and offers himself against
the said Oswald in the place aforesaid and the Sheriff aforesaid Returns to the Court house the Justices where he
