Charles County Esq^r hereby Certifie that on the 21 December 1718 I Replevied Jane & Henrietta two of the Negroes within mentioned in the Presence of Giles Green Senior and Giles Green Junior and on the same day I Replevied Negro Name within mentioned in the Presence of Mr Canwood and Thomas Macpherson Good and Lawfull men of my Baily witness which said Negroes delivered to the within mentioned Ralph Roby of which the within Named Thomas Canwood had Notice on the 15 January last in the Presence of Edward Jenkins and Thomas Macpherson like Good and Lawfull men of my Baily witness
