 on the second Tuesday in November Next and he hath it and the same day is given to the same James  
 and Ignatius here &c.

At which day to wit the second Tuesday in November aforesaid Comes as well the said  
 James and Ignatius by their Attorneys aforesaid as the said Philip by his Attorney aforesaid and the said Philip  
 by his said Attorney Prays further Licence thereof to Imparole here until the next Court to be

And now here at this day to wit the second  
 Tuesday in March aforesaid Comes as well the said James and Ignatius by their Attorneys aforesaid as the said  
 Philip by his Attorney aforesaid and the said Philip by his said Attorney Comes and defends the  
 Force and Justice Debt and Damages and whatever Else he ought to defend when and where the  
 Court will Consider thereof and the said Philip Prays Judgment of the Declaration of the said  
 James and Ignatius aforesaid because he saith that the said Declaration and the Subject matter  
 therein contained are in sufficient in Law for them the said James and Ignatius to maintain their  
 said Action against the said Philip to which Declaration the said Philip is under no necessity or  
 in any wise bound by the Law of the Land to answer and this he is ready to Verify and for  
 Cause of Delay in this Part according to the form of the Statute in such Cases made and Provided he  
 shews to the Court here the Causes following in that the aforesaid James and Ignatius aforesaid have  
 declared in a Plea of Debt of Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty and nine pence of Tobacco  
 as due to them in their own proper Right which they ought not to have done but declared as  
 Executors of Vincent Ashin their Testator or in whose Right the said Debt if any was due and for  
 recovery the Recovery if any should be the same being a Plea another Cause of delay is that  
 they the said James and Ignatius have declared in a Plea of Debt of Four Thousand Seven  
 Hundred and Twenty and nine Pence of Tobacco which to them the said Philip owes & unjustly  
 Detains which they as Executors ought not to have done but ought to have declared in a Plea of Debt  
 of Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Nine Pence of Tobacco which from them as  
 Executors the said Philip unjustly detains and a further Cause of delay in this Part is that they  
 the said James and Ignatius have declared without any Project of Letters Testamentary which they  
 ought not to have done but ought to have made a Project of the Letters Testamentary of the said  
 Vincent Ashin the only thing that can give them a Right to this Action and that it might have  
 sufficiently appeared to the Court here that they said James and Ignatius are Executors of the said  
 Vincent
