 go without Day. And it is further considered by the Court that the afo. said
 Thomas do recover against the afo. James and Ignatius the Sum of Three Hundred and Forty
 Three Pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by them Sustained about his defence afo.
 in this Behalf Adjudged to the same Thomas by the Court, according to the form of the Statute in
 the like case thereupon made and Provided, and the same Thomas have Execution of the

And thereupon the same John by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney complains that
 whereas the said Thomas the 5th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
 Hundred and forty six at Charles County afo. was indebted to the said John Macdonald in
 the sum of seven Hundred and twenty nine Pounds of Tobacco for divers Articles lying
 properly in an account as by the Particular Account there of here with into Court brought
 may appear and being so the afo. indebted the afo. Thomas Warren in consideration thereof
 to wit the day and year afo. at the County afo. Upon himself assumed and to the said John
 Macdonald then and there faithfully promised that he the afo. Thomas Warren the afo. Sum of
 seven Hundred and twenty nine pounds of Tobacco to the said John Macdonald when he went to
 afterwards he should be requested to do and truly would content and pay NEVER the less the
 afo. Thomas Warren his Promise and Assumption afo. not regarding but minding and
 fraudulently Intending the same John Macdonald in this Part craftily and Subtly to deceive
 and defraud, the afo. Thomas Warren the said Sum of seven Hundred and twenty nine Pounds of
 Tobacco or any Part thereof to the same John Macdonald hath not Paid nor him for the same in
 any sort contented at his the afo. Thomas Warren afterwards to wit the first day of June in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and forty seven and often afterwards at Charles
 County afo. by the same John Macdonald hath been Requested but the same to him hither to, to
 pay or him for the same in any sort to content hath hither to altogether Refused and still doth
 Refuse to the Damage of the same John Macdonald fourteen Hundred and fifty eight Pounds of
 Tobacco and there fore suit is brought and so forth
