 body into the Custody of the Sheriff by the above thereof tender. Thereupon the said Thomas Warren
 by Thomas Clark his Attorney comes and says that the a^d John, he being then Resident in the
 County a^d may give Security for the Costs which the said Thomas Warren may Expence in Prosecuting
 his suit according to the Rule and Practice here. At which the a^d Thomas Warren by Thomas Clark
 his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injuriousness a^d and Prays Licence thereof to Imparce
 here until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in June next and he
 hath it and the same day is given to the same John here a^d. At which day to wit the second Tuesday
 in June a^d comes as well the said John by his Attorney a^d as the said Thomas by his Attorney a^d
 and the said Thomas by his said Attorney Prays for the Licence thereof to Imparce here until the Next
