Peace for the County of Charles that is to say the said James Mathen in the sum of Forty Pounds Current money together with Thomas Hardman his main pensor in the sum of Forty Pounds likewise for his the said James Mathen's appearance to answer the same and not to depart the same

Whereupon Henry Darnall Esq: his Lordships attorney General Bretonus gives the Court here to understand and be informed that the said James Mathen was and still is guilty of Beating and Chastising the Body of Joseph McDonald. Therefore it is considered that the said James Mathen be and he be bound to the sum of Forty or Thirty Shillings Current money for his offence as aforesaid by the Court here adjudged according to the force and effect of the act of Assembly in those Cases last made and Provided and the said James Mathen be taken the same

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person came Samuel Chuan of Charles County Planter and becomes Pledge and Security for the aforesaid James Mathen to pay the Fine aforesaid as also the several fees which are due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court here by Occasion of the Premises. Ruled that the said James Mathen

do give in the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money of Maryland with sufficient Security in the like sum for his the said James Mathen's maintaining and keeping Harmless the County of Charles from any further or Expence by means of not providing for the Beating and Chastising of Joseph McDonald was this day Convicted of

Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes the said James Mathen of Charles County Planter and Samuel Chuan of same County Planter and do acknowledge themselves to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Forty Pounds Current money each which sums they and each and each of them severally and Grant should and might be made and Levied on their and each of their Person's Goods or Chattels Lands and Tenements for the Use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors

On Condition that the said James Mathen shall save keep harmless and indemnified the County of Charles from any further Charge or Expence that may happen by means of not providing for or maintaining the Beating and Chastising of Joseph McDonald is this day Convicted of

But remember that on this day to wit the second Tuesday in June aforesaid into Court here in his proper person comes Jasper Hennick of the County aforesaid Planter according to the Tenor of a certain Recognizance taken before the Worshipfull Mr. Allen Davies one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid that is to say the said Jasper Hennick in the sum of Forty Pounds Current money of Maryland together with Richard Adams his main pensor in the sum of Twenty Pounds likewise for his the said Jasper's appearance to answer the same and not to depart the same

Whereupon Henry Darnall Esq: his Lordships attorney General Bretonus gives the Court here to understand and be informed that the said Jasper Hennick was and still is guilty of breaking his Lordships Peace on the Body of William Overfield
