

He be Guilty of the Trespass and assault aforesaid soon time Impressed saith that he is in no wise thereof guilty but for that he will not contend with his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in this Part He humbly submits himself to the Court & therefore it is Considered that the said Jesper Hennrich be fined the sum of one thousand Pounds of Tobacco for the offence aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and that the said Jesper betaken to. Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes comes Samuel Love of Charles County Planter and becomes Pledged Security for the said Jesper Hennrich to pay the fine aforesaid and also the several fees arisen due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court here by Occasion of the Premises.

Ruled that the said Jesper Hennrich Recognize in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current money with sufficient security in the sum of Twenty Pounds like money for his Good Behaviour to and Appearance at the Next County Court to be here holden on the second Tuesday in August Next. Thereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes the said Jesper Hennrich of Charles County Planter and Samuel Love of same County Planter and acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Jesper Hennrich in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current money and the said Samuel Love in the sum of Twenty Pounds like money which sums they and each of them severally yielded and granted should and might be levied on their and each of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to and for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors.

The Condition of which Recognizance is that if the above bounden Jesper Hennrich shall Personally appear at the Next County Court to be holden for this County to do and receive what shall be then and there Enjoined him by the said Court and in the mean time that he be of Good Behaviour toward his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province then this Recognizance to be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and Virtue. — It is Remember'd that the said Jesper Hennrich together with his main Remor Richard Adams from the force and Effect of the Recognizance aforesaid taken aforesaid before the Worshipfull M. Allen Davison are acquitted and Discharged.

William Bryan on his motion to the Court is admitted to keep Ordinary at his House at Piles Fresh requiring Security according to the Direction of the Acts of Assembly in those Cases late made and Provided. — Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person comes the said William Bryan and acknowledge himself to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money of Maryland and also in like Manner came James Roasmun and Thomas Coleman of Charles County Planters and acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship in the sum of Twenty Pounds like Money each which sums they and every of them severally yielded and granted should be made and levied on their and every of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors.
