Therefor it is Considered that the said Jesper Hennick be fined the sum of One
Thousand Pounds of Tobacco for the offence ap^d: by the court here adjudged and that this
Jesper betaken &c^o Whereupon into Court here in his proper Person Comes
Comes Samuel Love of Charles County Planter and becomes Pledge and Security
for the afo^r Jesper Hennick to pay the fine ap^d: and Also the several fees arisun due to the
Officers and Ministers of the Court here by occasion of the Premises.—

Ruled that the said Jesper Hennick Recognise in the sum of Twenty Pounds curr^r
money with sufficient security in the sum of Twenty Pounds like money for his
Good Behaviour to and appearance at the next County Court to be held on
the second Tuesday in August next. Thereupon into Court here in his proper
Person Comes the afo^r Jesper Hennick of Charles County Planter and Samuel Love
of same County Planter and acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted
to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Jesper Hennick In
the sum of Twenty Pounds Current money and the said Samuel Love In the sum of Twenty
Pounds like money which sums they and Each of them severally Acknowledged and Granted
should and might be levied on their and Each of their Goods and Chattles Lands and
Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors.—

The Condition of which Recognition is that if the above bounden Jesper Hennick
shall Personally appear at the next County Court to be held for this County to do and
receive what shall be then and there Enjoyned him by the said Court and in the mean time
that he be of Good Behaviour toward his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other
People of this Province then this Recognition to be void otherwise to be and remain in full
force and Virtue.— *Please Remember* that the afo^r Jesper Hennick together with
his main Person Richard Adams from the force and Effect of the Recognition afo^r taken away
before the Worshippfull M^r Allen Davies are Acquitt and Discharged.—

William Bryan on his motion to the Court admitted to keep Ordinary at his
House at Piles's Fresh beginning security according to the Direction of the Act of Assembly
in those Cases late made and provided.— Whereupon into Court here in his
proper Person Comes the afo^r William Bryan and acknowledged himself to owe and stand Justly
Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary In the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money
of Maryland and also in like Manner Came James Roammans of Charles County
Planter and acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship In the
sum of Twenty Pounds like Money Each which sum they and Every of them severally Acknowledged
and Granted should be made and levied on their and Every of their Goods and Chattles Lands and
Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors.—

On Condition that the said William Bryan do make good Rules and Orders and do
