Clement Kennedy Presents to the Court here the following Petition Viz.

To the Worshipfull the Justices of Charles County now in Court setting the Petition of Clement Kennedy of said County, in humble manner sheweth. That whereas your Petitioner is desirous in fee of a tract or Parcel of Land lying in said County, called Frog. Next, the bounds thereof being Precarious, therefore desire your Worships will grant him a Commission to Examine Evidences touching the bounds of the same and he as in duty bound will ever Pray &c.

Whereupon it is ordered that Commission You Returnable here &c. to Richard Harrison, Joseph Hanson Harrison, Robert Culvert and John Starnall Gentlemen or any Three or Two of them to Examine Evidences touching the bounds of the said Parcel of Land.

Ventry of William and Mary Parish Presents to the Court here the following Petition Viz.

To the Worshipfull the Justices of Charles County now sitting in Court. The Petition of the Vestry of William and Mary Parish Humbly sheweth. That whereas the Vestry of said Parish have surveyed and Reported of the Quantity of one Hundred and fifty Acres of Land lying and being in the Parish aforesaid now known and called by the Name of Globe Land and your Petitioner Humbly moves to your Worships to grant them a Commission to Prove and Perpetuate the Boundaries of said Land and your Petitioner shall Pray &c. Whereupon it is ordered that Commission You Returnable here &c. to Peter Hood, James Nicolson, Samuel Chunn and Samuel Love Junior Gentlemen or any Three or Two of them to Examine Evidences touching the Boundaries of the said Tract of Land.

Baker Brooks Presents to the Court here the following Petition Viz.

To the Worshipfull Justices of Charles County the Petition of Robert Brooke Humbly sheweth that your Petitioner is in Possession of two Tracts of Land lying in the County afo. Viz. Goose Creek and Chandler Mount. The Boundaries of which is uncertain your Petitioner therefore Prays your Worships would Grant Commission to Prove and Perpetuate the Memory of the Boundaries of the afo. Lands and he as in duty bound will Pray &c. Whereupon it is ordered that Commission You Returnable here &c. to Thomas Stone, William Hanson, Matthew Stone, and Richard Stone Gentlemen or any Three or Two of them to Examine Evidences touching the Boundaries of the said Tracts of Land.

Walter Hanson Guardian to Robert Hanson son of the late Colonel Robert Hanson Presents to the Court here the following View of the Land and Premises of the said Orphan, which is by the Court here Ordered to be Recorded. Charles County sh. To the Worshipfull Justices of Charles County sheweth hereby that on the seventeenth of April 1759 Messrs. Francis Ware and William Neale Came before me and made Oath on the Holy Evangelists that according to the Best of their Skill and Judgment they would make a just Estimate of the annual Value of the Land and Premises now in Possession of Walter Hanson the Property of an Orphan of the late Deceased Colonel Robert Hanson called Robert to whom the said Walter is appointed Guardian and what dwelling Houses out Houses & orchards are upon the same and what Repair they are in what Part of the said Land the said Guardian may be further Permitted to Clear upon the said Plantation as well to Raise the yearly Rent so Valued afo. as also to order his yearly Charge in keeping the said dwelling Houses orchards & gardens in Repair and so by him to be Left.
