But remember'd that heretofore to wit the second Tuesday in March last by the Oath of fifteen Jurors namely Peter Wood &c. was presented Jane Wicks for bearing a bastard Child. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in June aforesaid the aforesaid Jane Wicks in Custody of the Sheriff namely Samuel Hanson Gentleman to the Court here brought in her Proper Person Comes and being demanded of her by the Court here whether she be guilty of the Bastardy aforesaid upon her Imposed by the said Jane Wicks that she is thereof guilty in manner and form as by the Presentment aforesaid against her it is alleged. Therefore it is Considered that the said Jane Wicks be fined only for Corporal Punishment according to the Directions of the Act of Assembly in these Cases late made and Provided, and for that the said Jane cannot lay or procure any Person to be Security for the fine aforesaid by the Act aforesaid Imposed. It is ordered the Sheriff that he take her to the Whipping Post and having whipped her naked from the Waist upwards that give her Twelve Lashes on the Bare Back for her offence aforesaid. And afterwards to wit the same second Tuesday in June aforesaid the Sheriff aforesaid returns to the Court here that he hath done Execution of the said Judgment upon the aforesaid Jane Wicks. Whereupon into Court here in his Proper Person Comes Thomas Holland of Charles County Planter and becomes Pledge and Security for the aforesaid Jane Wicks to pay the several fees arising due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court here by occasion of the Premises. Whereupon it is by the Court here further Considered that the said Jane Wicks do owe her Master one year and a half Inconsideration of the Loss of Time and Trouble of his House and the fees arising due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court here by occasion of the Premises.
