 And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in June aforesaid the aforesaid Grace Brict by William Middleton her Attorney Comes and being Demanded of her by the Court here whether she be guilty of the Bastardy afo. above upon her Impoised she the said Grace Brict saith she is thereof guilty in manner and form as by the Decretment afo. against her it is alledged. Therefore it is Considered that the said Grace Brict be fined Six Hundred Pounds of Tobacco or Thirty Shillings Current Money for her offence by the Court here adjudged according to the force and effect of the Act of Assembly in those Cases late made and Provided and the said Grace Brict be taken &c.
