

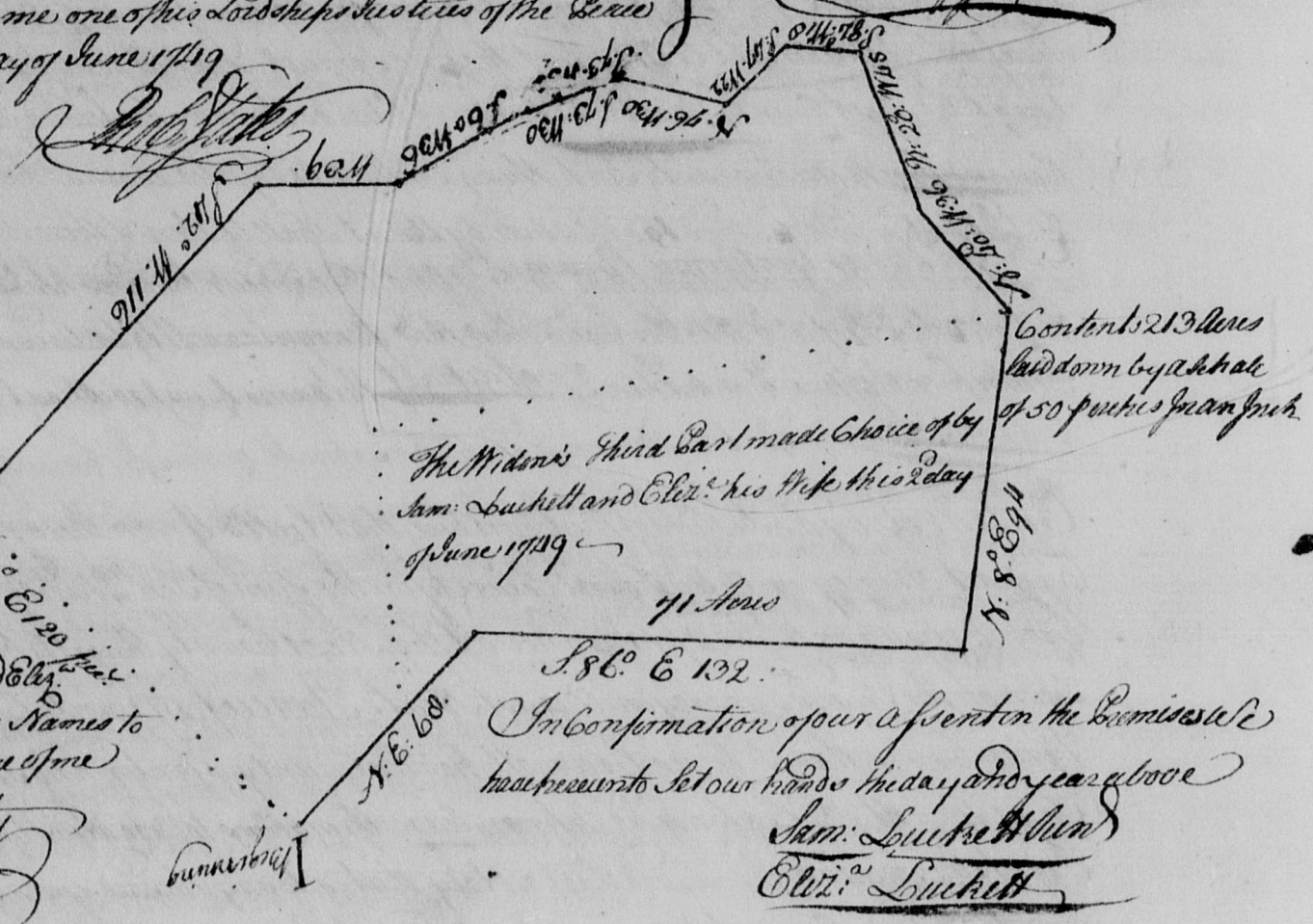
June Court Anno Domini 1719

Elizabeth wife of the said Samuel, who was the Petitioner of said Henry Ashua James on, had made her Choice of one Third Part of said Plantation, as appears by the Plat here unto annexed And also the said Samuel and Elizabeth have Declared the same by subscribing their Names unto the said Plat. We do find on the Two Thirds of the said Plantation now laid out for the Use & Support of the Heir of said Henry Ashua James on, one Old Forty feet Tobacco House, in bad Repair, about Six Hundred and Forty Panels of Good Fencing forty Old Beach Trees within the Corryfield, and about forty bearing Apple Trees, and we allow the Guardian under whose Care the said Heir is, or hereafter may be to fall, and Wall Rail Timber sufficient to keep the Present Fencing in Good Repair, within Twenty yards of the Fencing as it now stands, and to Clear in the Northernmost Corner of the Plantation Next to the Tobacco House, about Forty Shews Tobacco Hills, and no more, as also Board Timber to Repair the Old Tobacco House, and we do judge the yearly Value, of the said Two Thirds to be Eight Hundred Pounds of Tobacco. In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 2<sup>d</sup> Day of June 1719.

This may satisfy whom it may Concern, that the above named Peter Wood & John Riggs took the Oath in such Cases Prescribed by an Act of Assembly of this Province, and that the above Division, Division and Choice, were all made and done before me one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for said County this 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1719
