Ordered by the Court here that Bench Warrant Issue Directed to the Sheriff of Charles County to take Pat. M'Qued to answer unto what shall be objected against the returnable to the Second Tuesday in August Next.

But Remember'd that Samuel Luckett together with his main Error Tho: Hussey Luckett from the force and Effect of a certain Recognizance taken before the Justices of Charles County the first Sessions of this Court are acquitted and Discharged. Ruled that the said Samuel Luckett Recognize in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money with sufficient Security in the sum of Twenty Pounds like Money for his Good Behaviour to and appearance at the County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in August Next. Thereupon into Court here in his Proper Person Comes the said Samuel Luckett of Charles County Inhabitant and William Middleton of same County Gentleman and Acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Samuel Luckett in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money and the said William Middleton in the sum of Twenty like Money which Sums they and each of them severally Yielded and Granted should and might be levied on their and each of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to and for the Use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. on Condition that the said Samuel Luckett do make his Personal appearance here at the Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in August Next there and there to answer unto such things as shall be objected against him on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and to stand to and abide by what shall be then & there Enjoined him by the said Court, and in the meantime that he be of good Behaviour towards his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province then this Recognizance to be void otherwise to be void Remain in full force and Virtue & not depart the same Court without License thereof

Ordered by the Justices of the Court here that Giles Green Recognize Twenty Pounds Current Money with sufficient Security in the sum of Ten Pounds like Money for his Good Behaviour to and appearance at the Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in August Next. Thereupon into Court here in his Proper Person Comes the said Giles Green of Charles County Planter and John Beale Junior of same County Planter and Acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Giles Green in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money and the said John Beale Junior in the sum of Ten Pounds like Money which Sums they and each of them severally Yielded and Granted should and might be levied on their and each of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to and for the Use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. on Condition that the said Giles Green do make his Personal appearance here at the Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in August Next there and there to answer unto such things as shall be objected against him on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary & stand to & abide by what shall be then & there Enjoined him by the said Court, and in the meantime that he be of good Behaviour towards his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province then this Recognizance to be void otherwise to be void Remain in full force & Virtue
