At which day to wit the second Tuesday in June aforesaid Comes as well the said Francis by his Attorney aforesaid as the said Richard by his Attorney aforesaid and the said Richard by his said Attorney Prays for the Licence thereof to Imparle here until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in August Next and he hath it and the same day is given to the same Francis here &c. At which day to wit the second Tuesday in August aforesaid Comes as well the said Francis by his Attorney aforesaid as the said Richard by his Attorney aforesaid and the said Richard by his said Attorney Prays for the Licence thereof to Imparle here until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November Next and he hath it and the same day is given to the same Francis here &c. At which day to wit the second Tuesday in November aforesaid Comes as well the said Francis by his Attorney aforesaid as the said Richard by his Attorney aforesaid and the said Richard by his said Attorney Prays for the Licence thereof to Imparle here until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next and he hath it and the same day is given to the same Francis here &c. At which day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid Comes as well the said Francis by his Attorney aforesaid as the said Richard by his Attorney aforesaid and the said Richard by his said Attorney Prays for the Licence thereof to Imparle here until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in June Next and he hath it and the same day is given to the same Francis here &c. And the said Richard Roby by his said Attorney Comes and defends the force and Injury when he said and saith that he Cannot deny the Action aforesaid of him the said Francis nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Francis against him hath complained nor also but that the said Francis hath sustained Damages by means of not performing the Promises and Assurances aforesaid to one thousand four Hundred and Seventy Two Pounds of Tobacco as the said Francis does in declaration suppose. Whereupon the said Francis by his Attorney aforesaid Prays Judgment and those Damages to be acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this Part laid out and Expended to him to be Adjudged. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Francis do Pray against the said Richard Roby his Damages aforesaid to one thousand four Hundred and Seventy Two Pounds of Tobacco also the sum of One Hundred and Eighty Nine Pounds of Tobacco for his Costs & Charges by him about his said suit in this Part laid out and Expended on his behalf by the Court here Adjudged that this in the
