Aforesaid not regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the same Edward and Thomas in this Part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said John the said Sum of Eight Hundred and Ninety Pounds of Tobacco or any Part thereof to the same Edward & Thomas hath not paid nor them for the same in any sort Contented with the said John afterwards to wit the fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty eight & after afterwards at Charles County afo. by the same Edward and Thomas hath been requested but the same to him to wit the said John or them for the same in any sort to Content hath hither to altogether refused and still doth refuse to the Damage of the same Edward and Thomas one Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Pounds of Tobacco And therefore Suit is brought and so forth.
