And Wm Middleton by Thomas Clark his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. and Pray Licence thereof to Imparl hereunto the next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next and he hath it & the same day is given to the same James here &c. And which day to wit the second Tuesday in March of 1719 comes here as well the said James by his Attorney & as the said William by his said Attorney Pray further Licence thereof to Imparl here until the next Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in June Next and he hath it and the same day is given to the same James here &c. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in June of 1719 comes here as well the said James by his Attorney & as the said Wm in his proper Person and the said William in his proper Person comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the Action of him James nor but that he did a promise upon himself in manner and form as the said James against him hath complained nor also but that the said James hath sustained Damages by means of not performing the Promises & a sum of money of 10000 and thirty pounds of Tobacco and fifty seven pounds twelve shillings and two pence half penny sterling as the said James above in aading supposes.
