in any sort Contented altho the said James afterwards to wit the Twenty Ninth day of March afo.
the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine and often afterwards at Charles
County sh. by the same Thomas hath been Requested, but the same to him hither to, to Pay or him for the
same in any sort to Content he hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the damage of
the same Thomas Five Thousand six Hundred and forty Two Pounds of Absus and the sum of which is
