And the aforesaid John by Thomas Clark his attorney comes, as well as the said Thomas by his attorney afo. and the said Thomas by his said Attorney says that the said John to his Declaration afo. against him may answer and the said John by his attorney afo. James & defends the force and Injury when &c. and the same Attorney says that he is not informed of any Answer to the said Thomas for the said John. In the Plea afo. to be given and nothing further thereof does he say where by the same Thomas remains against the said John these upon without defence

It is therefore Considered by the Court here that the said Thomas do recover against the said John the Damages by Occasion of the Premises said which by the Justice of the Court here are a just 1 to the Pound 10s. 10d. and Nine Pence Sterling and Eight Hundred and seven Pounds of Tobacco (except Eight Shillings and four Pence Sterling) and also the sum of one Hundred Eighty seven pounds and one Quarter of a Pound of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this Court said Def. in me out and Expended to the said Thomas of his Assent by the Court here adjudged and the said John in me

Charles County sh. James Beets late of Charles County Planter was Attached to Answer unto Thomas Hungerford of a Plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth

And whereupon the same Thomas by Jeremiah Chaves his attorney complains that Whereas the said James the day of In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty eight at Charles County afo. was indebted to the said Thomas in the sum of Nine hundred & fifty Pounds of Tobacco for divers Articles lying Properly in an account as by the Particular account thereof herewith into Court brought may appear and being so thereof indebted the afo. James in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year afo. at the County afo. upon himself Assumed and to the said Thomas then and there faithfully promised that he the afo. James the afo. sum of Nine hundred and fifty Pounds of Tobacco to the said Thomas when thereunto afterwards he should be requested and truly would content and pay. Nevertheless the afo. James his Promise and Assumption afo. not regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the same Thomas in this Part Craftily and Subtly to deceive and defraud the afo. James the afo. sum of Nine hundred and fifty Pounds of Tobacco or any Part thereof to the same Thomas hath not Paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented altho the afo. James afterwards to wit the first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty nine and afterwards at Charles County afo. by the same Thomas hath been Requested but the same to him hither to to Pay or him for the same in any sort to Content hath hither to altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the damage of the same Thomas one thousand Nine hundred Pounds of Tobacco And therefore Suit is brought and so forth
